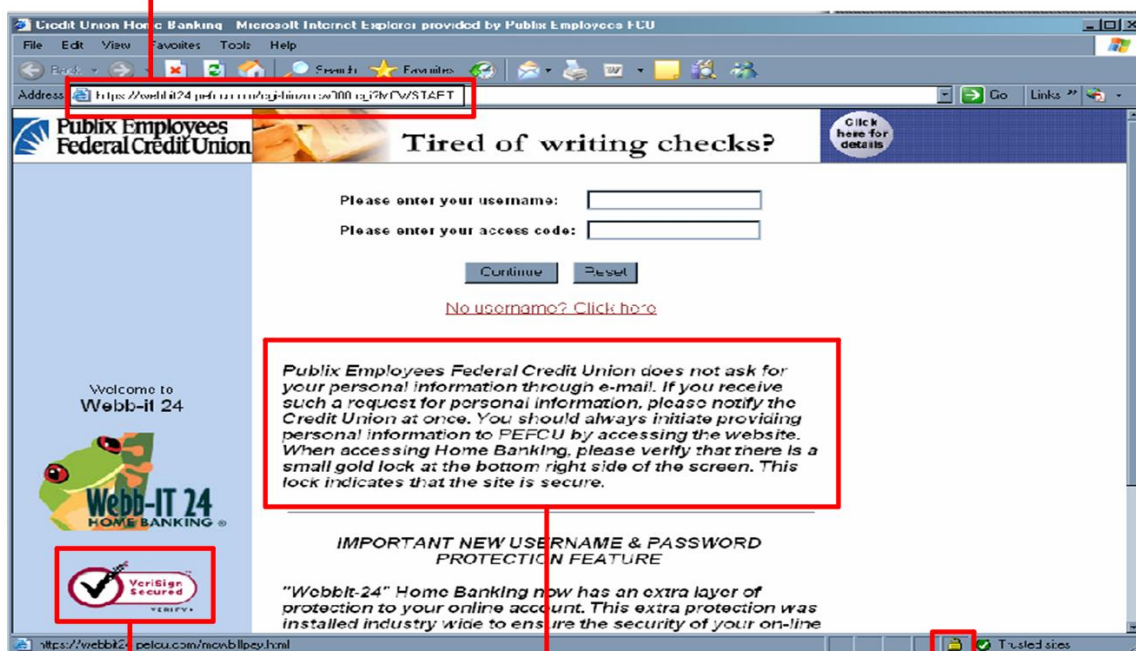


# SECURITY TIPS

## How to Identify the Real PEFCU Home Banking Website

PEFCU is providing these security tips in an effort to educate our members in identifying the true PEFCU Home Banking website and to assist in safeguarding our members from “phishing” scams on the internet.

## 1. Web Site Address (URL)

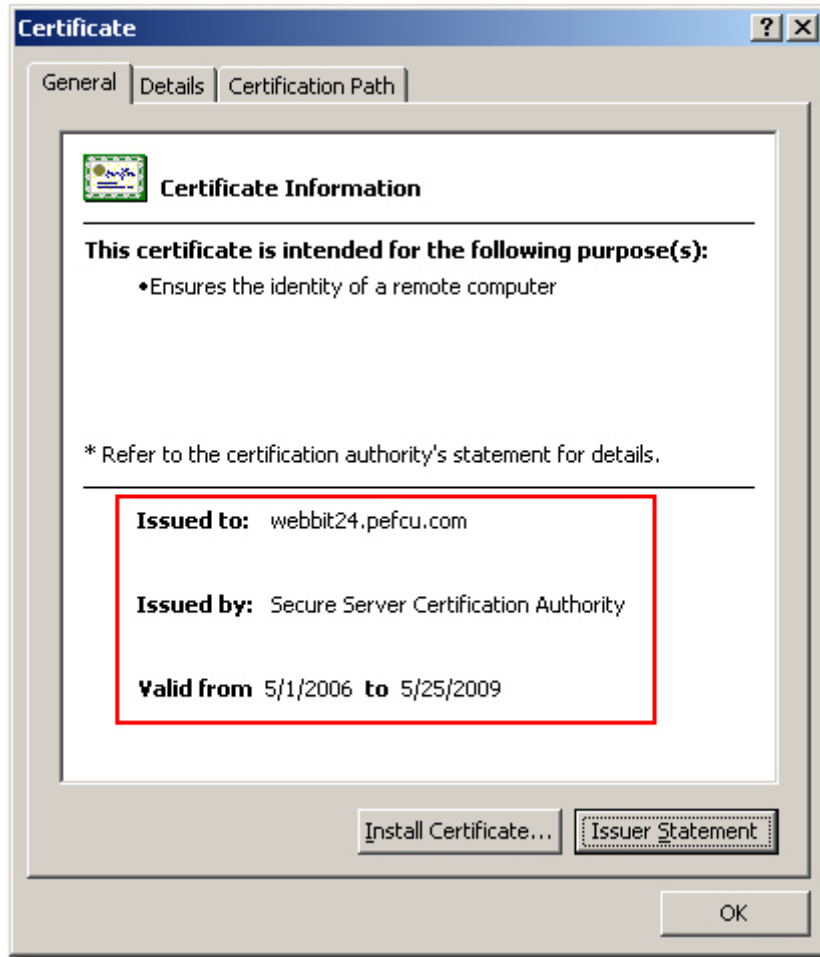
The web site address for PEFCU Home Banking will ALWAYS read as follows:

<https://webbit24.pefcu.com/cgi-bin/mcw000.cgi?MCWSTART>

There will never be any other characters or numbers contained in this URL or web site address. Also, notice the letter ‘s’ after the ‘http’ which indicates that this is a Secure web site.

## 2. Security Report

The lock on the top or bottom of the window (depending on the browser version you are using) will display certification information about the web site. When you click the lock, you will see a window similar to the one below. Notice inside the red square our web site domain and validity dates.

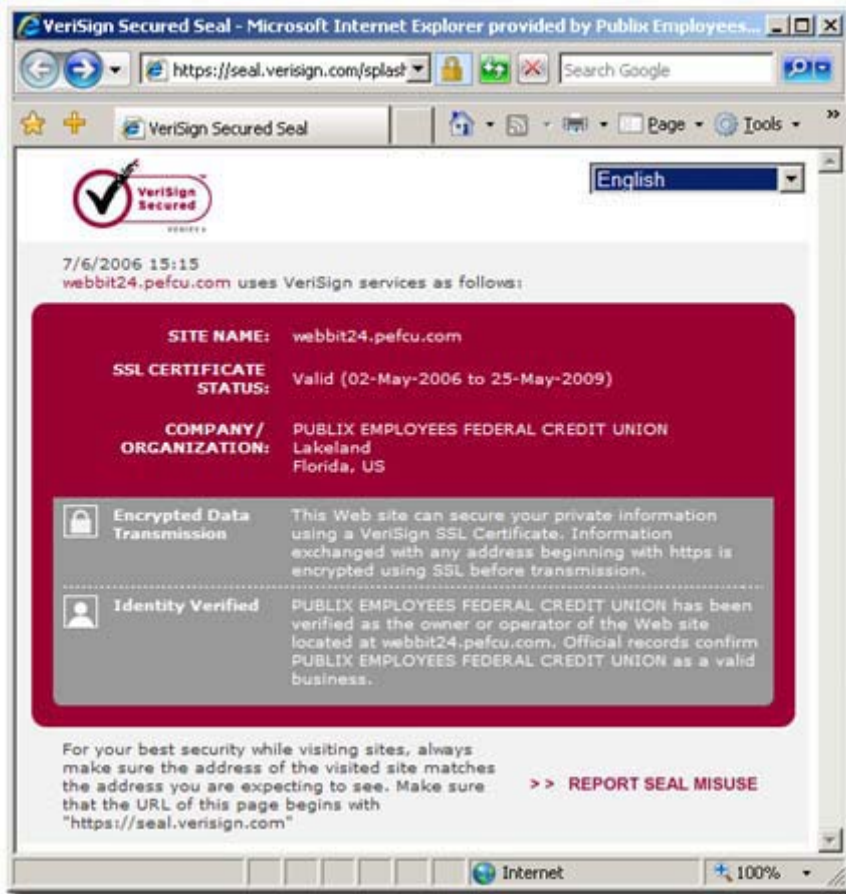


## 3. VeriSign Security Logo

As an added layer of security and peace of mind for our members, we have teamed up with VeriSign to provide validation of our web site to you, our members. When you click the VeriSign logo on the PEFCU Home Banking web site, you will see another screen pop up on top of your current screen (*make sure your pop-up blocker is disabled or configured to allow PEFCU pop-up windows*)

this will display additional valid information about Publix Employees Federal Credit Union.

The screen will display the date, time, web site address, SSL certificate status, company name, city, state, encryption information and identity verification.



#### 4. PEFCU Security Advice

The security advice we have on our website is to ensure you that we will NOT, under any circumstances request any type of personal information from you via e-mail. If you receive any type of e-mail requesting you to click a link and enter any kind of personal information, such as a login id, account information, password or credit card information, please do not enter the information. Do not respond to the email at all, just delete it immediately.
